

## Protect your G-mail with 2-Step Verification

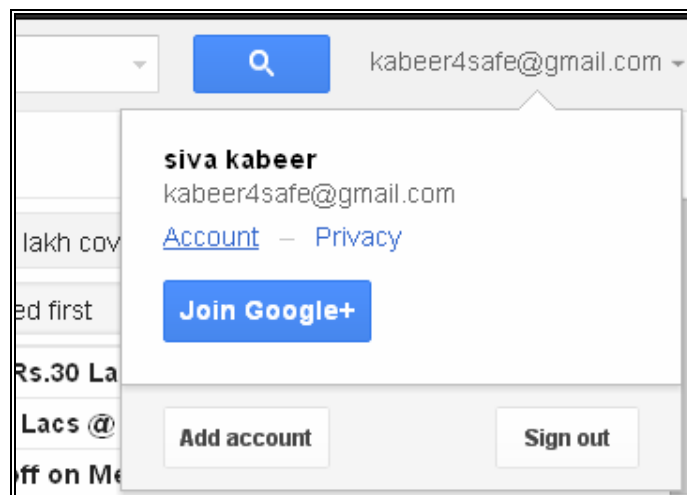
Log in with your **Password + SMS Code** sent for your mobile

**Now-a-days most of the g-mails were getting hacked**

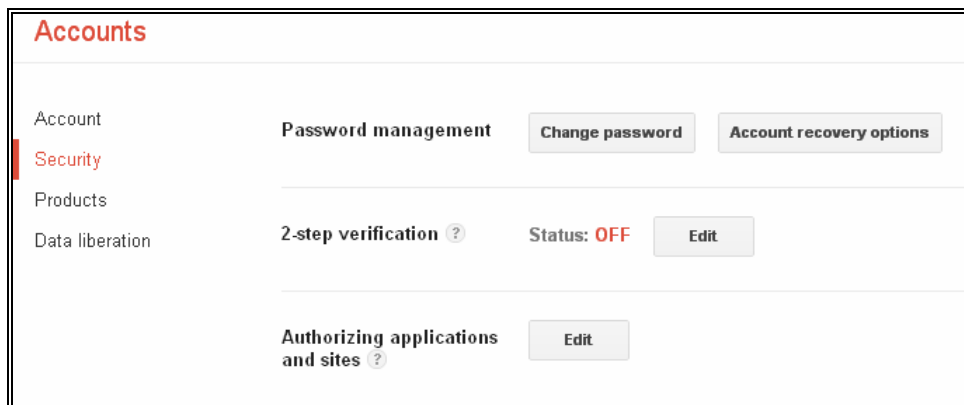
To have high end protection keep one more security level other than mail id and password explained below

**LOGIN** to your GMAIL account

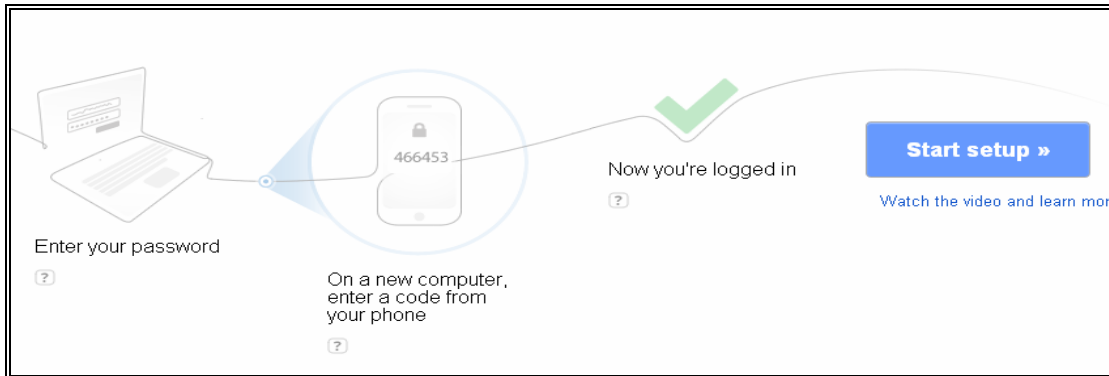
**GOTO** account settings

**Login & then Click Start Setup button**

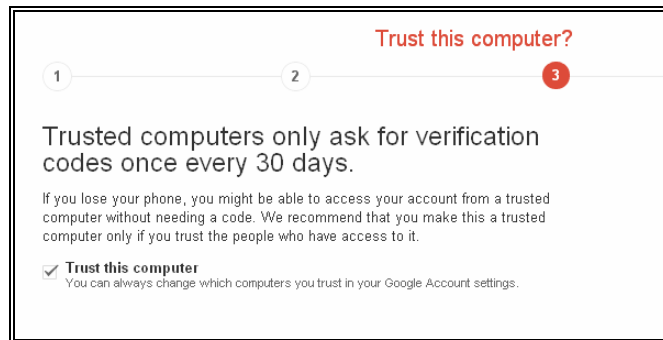


**Configure your mobile number and enter the code received by sms from google for verification**

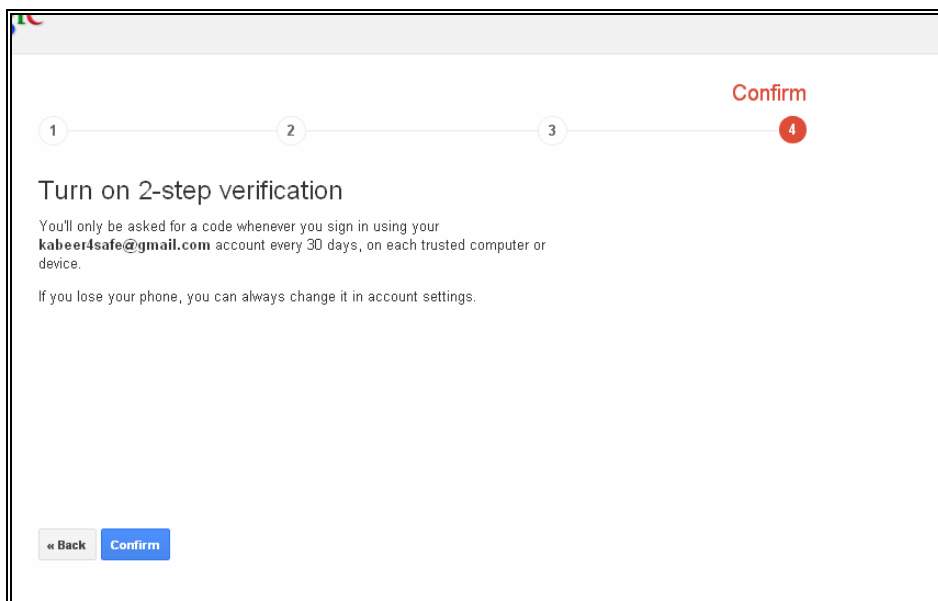

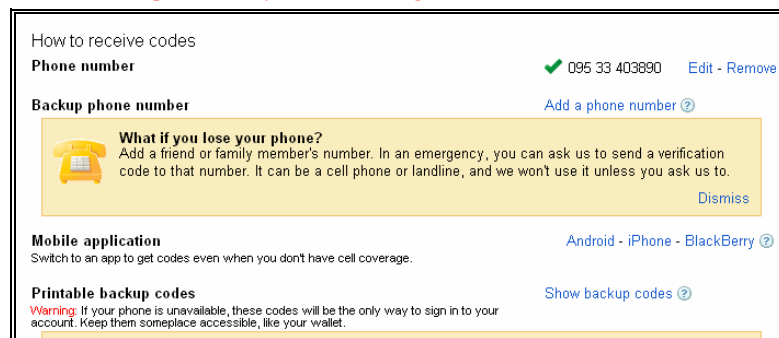
**UNCHECK the remember this computer for 30 days checkbox**
